

## <u>Year 8 Drama - Knowledge Organiser – Term 3</u> The Terrible fate of Humpty Dumpty by David Calcutt

Do you think he is responsible for Terry's death? Or others to blame? Is there enough evidence?






	A promise made by a <b>witness</b> or an accused to tell the truth in <b>court</b> when giving evidence.
Defendant	A person who is being sued or accused of a crime in a court of law.
Prosecution lawyer	Lawyer <u>against</u> the defendant
Court clerk	The <b>court</b> officer who oversees administrative functions, especially managing the flow of cases through the <b>court</b> .
Defence lawyer	Represents the defendant in court
The jury	Member of the <b>jury</b> . <b>Jury</b> : Specific number of people (usually 6 or 12) selected as prescribed by law to render a verdict in a trial.
Manslaughter	A person is guilty of manslaughter where he unlawfully kills any person but is not guilty of murder due to the partial defences of 'diminished responsibility'.
Conviction / convicted	The act of finding somebody guilty of a crime in court; the fact of having been found guilty.
Evidence	What a witness says during a trial is evidence. Evidence can also be in the form of physical items such as documents, photographs
