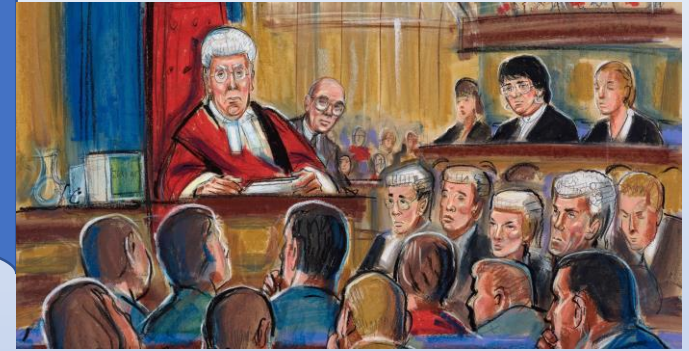




Stubb's Trial in court. You will take part in a mock trial to find out if Stubb be sentenced for Manslaughter or Murder ?

KEY WORDS

Witness	A promise made by a witness or an accused to tell the truth in court when giving evidence.
Defendant	A person who is being sued or accused of a crime in a court of law.
Prosecution lawyer	Lawyer <u>against</u> the defendant
Court clerk	The court officer who oversees administrative functions, especially managing the flow of cases through the court.
Defence lawyer	<u>Represents</u> the defendant in court
The jury	Member of the jury. Jury: Specific number of people (usually 6 or 12) selected as prescribed by law to render a verdict in a trial.
Manslaughter	A person is guilty of manslaughter where he unlawfully kills any person but is not guilty of murder due to the partial defences of 'diminished responsibility'.
Conviction / convicted	The act of finding somebody guilty of a crime in court; the fact of having been found guilty.
Evidence	What a witness says during a trial is evidence. Evidence can also be in the form of physical items such as documents, photographs...
