
The Elements of Music





| Key term | Description |
|----------|---|
| Chord | 2 or more notes played at the same time. In normal position on the keyboard we can make a chord by playing a note, missing one, playing one and missing one i.e. C major chord = C, E and G played together |
| Major | A positive sounding scale or chord i.e C major scale = C,D,E,F,G,A,B,C |
| Minor | A sad / mysterious sounding scale or chord i.e. A minor goes A, B,C,D,E,F,G#, A |
| Tab | Music written for instruments such as Guitar which shows pictures/ diagrams of where to place fingers. |
| Stave | The five lines that we write conventional music onto. |
