Introduction to the London Dungeons

Location: The London Dungeons is a popular tourist attraction located on the South Bank of the River Thames in London, England.

Historical Background: The London Dungeons offer an immersive and interactive experience that showcases the darker side of London's history, including its crime, punishment, and supernatural events.

Immersive Theatre	It's a performance art movement that aims to transform audience members from passive recipients to active participants
Improvisation	improvisation, in theatre, the playing of dramatic scenes without written dialogue and with minimal or no predetermined dramatic activity.
Audience interaction	A type of theatre where you involve the audience in some way. They are at the heart of your performance.
Over Exaggerated	Over the top acting.
Character research	Researching your character to enable you to perform realistically and accurately.
Monologue	Exploring the inner thoughts, experiences, and interactions of characters.

Historical Characters:

Sweeny Todd	Sweeney escaped from prison after being wrongfully accused and jailed for fifteen
	years. Formerly a proud barber, a loving husband and a happy father, Sweeney is
	now consumed by loss and revenge. He has returned to London to right the wrongs
	committed against him, his wife, and his daughter. Sweeney is charming but hot-
	tempered, ferocious yet vulnerable. Strong baritone/bass who can whistle. Speaks
	with an Estuary or London dialect.
Jack the ripper	Jack the Ripper was an English serial killer. Between August and November 1888, he
	murdered at least five women—all prostitutes—in or near the Whitechapel district
	of London's East End. Jack the Ripper was never identified or arrested.
Mrs Lovett	40s, Cockney accent, energetic, talkative, has a crush on Sweeney. There is a very
	slight edge of insanity to her and a streak of larcenyshe is motivated by desire
	for money, for love, for popularity. She is all bright eyes and smiles, but kills
	cockroaches and chops meat like a pro.
Guy Fawkes	Born a Protestant in York in 1570, Fawkes later converted to
	Catholicism. Intelligent, tough, and cool-headed, his qualities were noted by
	English Catholics. Winter learned of Fawkes's extensive expertise in explosives and
	convinced him to join the plot.

Understanding the background and motivations of these characters is essential for realistic portrayal.



Theatrical Techniques and Skills

Physicality: Actors at the London Dungeons use physicality to portray characters effectively, including body language, gestures, and facial expressions. You will need to embrace your characters through the use of physical skills.

Voice and Projection: You will have the ability to project and manipulate your voice to create different characters and convey emotions is crucial in the immersive environment. Using your voice to set the scene and create tension.

Improvisation: Given the interactive nature of the experience, actors must be use improvisation to engage with visitors and respond to unexpected situations.
