
Course Content

Art, Craft & Design allows students to follow 2+ titles from Fine Art, Graphic Communication, Textiles, Photography & 3D. Each of those 'titles' include many different processes from Print Making to using Light Based media. Students should be prepared to draw, photograph and colour as a basis for all investigation.

Component 1 (Coursework) 60% consisting of 2 X long term projects. This usually lasts from Autumn of Y10 to Winter Y11. Y10 currently studying 'Food' and 'Illustration'.

Component 2 (Externally Set Task/Exam) 40%. Exam paper comes out in January of Y11, preparation until late April and 10hrs exam/final response takes place in early May.

*All work (Unit 1 & 2) to be submitted by early - mid May.
