## Subjuntivo – Subjunctive phrases

| Cuando termine los exámenes  | - when I finish my exams  |
| Cuando salga del instituto   | - when I leave school     |
| Cuando vaya a la Universidad | - when I go to university |

## Revising *si* clauses

*Si* clauses occur in 'if' sentences, which often contain a combination of the present and the future tense. This structure is used to talk about something that will happen in the future, provided that something else happens in the present to make it possible.

*Si apruebo los exámenes, iré a la universidad* – If I pass my exams, I will go to university.

## Using *lo* and *lo que*

*Lo que* is used to mean 'what' when you are not asking a question.

*Lo que más importa es decidir mi futuro*. What matters most is to decide my future. *Lo* is used with an adjective to mean 'the ... thing'.

*Lo bueno es que he sacado buenas notas*. The good thing is that I have got good grades.

## Making deductions in reading and listening

Sometimes, in more complex texts, you are asked to explain or justify an answer. This usually means that you are required to make an assumption or arrive at a deduction from understanding the language you read or hear.

*Por la noche no puedo dormir porque me pasan todas las opciones por la mente y no tengo la más mínima idea de lo que debería hacer.*

If you were asked how students felt and to justify your answer, you could say that they were anxious or confused because they can't decide what to do.



He decidido que no quiero ir a la universidad y mi padre está furioso. Dice que en la sociedad actual, es esencial demostrar tus habilidades. Mi padre está especialmente obsesionado con ciertas asignaturas: cree que la biología y la geografía son fabulosas para entender el mundo pero que la fotografía y la psicología son inútiles. Está completamente seguro de su opinión y no acepta que es una cuestión de la personalidad de cada uno.
