

Sport Studies The 4 Units studied:

Mandatory Units Studied:

RO51 - Contemporary Issues in Sport (1 hour exam)

You will sit this exam in the summer term of Year 10

RO52 - Developing Sport Skills in an Individual and a Team game.

 This is a coursework based unit, where you will do some practical and some written coursework

Optional Units studied:

RO54 - Sport and the Media

RO56 - Developing Knowledge and Skills in Outdoor Activities

Both of these units are coursework units where you will complete a variety of written assignments





RO51 - Contemporary Issues in Sport

This is all about what is going on in the world of sport both at grass routes and at elite professional level.

You sit a 1 hour Exam which is marked by the Exam Board in the summer term of Year 10.

We will be learning the following topics:

- LO1 Understand the issues which affect participation in sport
- LO2 Know the role of sport in promoting values
- LO3 Understand the importance of hosting major sporting events
- LO4 Know about the Roles of National Governing Bodies in sport





RO52 - Developing Sports Skills

- Your PRACTICAL ability in Skills and Tactics,
- Your ability in OFFICIATING in one Sport.
- Written assignments in identifying strengths and weaknesses in your performance and the planning of how to improve your performance.
- LO1 Be able to use skills, techniques and tactics/strategies/compositional ideas as an individual performer in a sporting activity.
- LO2 Be able to use skills, techniques and tactics/strategies/compositional ideas as a team performer in a sporting activity.
- LO3 Be able to officiate in a sporting activity.
- LO4 Be able to apply practice methods to support improvement in a sporting activity





Optional Unit - R054 Sport and the Media

You will explore the relationship between sports and the media: how sport uses the media to promote itself and the media uses sport to expand and maintain uptake of its products.

You study the differences in sports coverage across a range of media outlets and over time and the effect that media has had on public interest and involvement in sport.

LO1: Know how sport is covered across the media

LO2: Understand positive effects that the media can have on sport

LO3: Understand negative effects that the media can have on sport

LO4: Understand the relationship between sport and the media





Optional Unit – <u>R056 Developing knowledge and skills in Outdoor Activities</u>

You will be completing written assignments and being assessed in your Practical Ability in 2 outdoor activities

- LO1 Know about different types of outdoor activities and their provision
- LO2 Understand the value of participating in outdoor activities
