# Hilbre High School <br> Curriculum Design 2020-21 <br> Year 9 

Year 9 is arranged into 9 forms with roughly 22 students in each form. Each year is split into an $X$ half and $Y$ half. Form groups are broadly mixed ability.

Students are streamed for some subjects in Year 9. Maths, Science and IT are taught in the same groups. English, Geography and History are in the same group. Students who started two languages in Year 8 will continue to study both French and Spanish. All other groups are roughly mixed ability.
