FLU JAB - A MESSAGE FROM TESCOS

For members of the public we are currently offering £9 per jab, but ask in store for a £1 off voucher to bring the cost down to £8. If you are considering 500+ flu jabs or vouchers there will be a significant saving on the flu jab / voucher price.

The vouchers can be paid for in store or can be arranged to be paid by BACS. Please let us know if you are interested now or in the future regarding this programme. (Tesco club card points are also available on the flu jabs!) Also anyone in the same household as a Tesco Privilege card holder has a colleague price of £4.50.

We are also this year again providing an NHS flu jab service for over 18 year olds, for those entitled to flu jabs free of charge who fall into risk categories and would have maybe had their jab at their GP; this includes (but not limited to) over 65s, pregnant, weakened immune system, long term respiratory conditions e.g. chronic asthma or chronic heart conditions to name but a few (only available currently in store).

The Pharmacy has one of the longest operating hours for a private flu clinic we believe on the Wirral / Merseyside, operating every day, Monday to Friday 8.40am-8pm, Saturday 8.40am-8pm and Sunday 10am-3pm from September 19th until March 2017. (times may vary subject to availability of staff and / or vaccines)

We can vaccinate anyone over the age of 12 privately (with parental consent) with a few exceptions due to medication or pregnancy. NHS service is over 18.

All services are subject to time changes and are at the discretion of the pharmacist at the time of vaccination.
