JANUARY ASSESSMENT: YEAR 7 AND YEAR 10

To inform the next Progress Reports to parents for Years 7 and 10, we will be formally testing students in these years, in all subjects.

Tests will be held in the week beginning January 18th at the latest. They will test subject content taught over the first term and for Year 7 will be an hour in duration. The Year 10 tests will replicate examination questions and students can expect to answer questions from a past examination paper (although there may be exceptions to this in some subjects.)

Please ensure that your child is well prepared for the tests in January; the best way to be prepared? Revise subject content from the first term. Students will receive further information about the tests, on their return in January.


