- Foundation Year - provides a route for students who may need extra Level 2 courses, including GCSE English Language and Mathematics. Students participate in a day's work experience and can choose from a range of Level 2 vocational courses.
- Our Higher Ability students perform exceptionally well and our results for this cohort put us in the top 10% of sixth form providers. Higher attaining students have the possibility of following 4 A level courses.
- We offer a blended curriculum of A level and vocational courses that enables excellent progression to University or Higher Apprenticeships for all students.
- Flexible learning pathways that include EPQ, health guidance and mental health support.
- From 2019 we are delighted to offer a suite of Rock School Level 3 Performing Arts courses in Music, Dance and Acting; ideal for students who wish to progress to Drama school, LIPA or University.
